Propose

You are not required to have your proposed major in MyUCSC listed as Network and Digital Technology in order to declare the major. However, it is recommended

Being a proposed major allows students • Major Qualification Courses: to:

- * be connected to advising
- * receive important communications
- * gain access to enrolling in some major courses that may be restricted to proposed majors.

Qualify

Complete **36 credits** of major qualification coursework (listed below) no later than the end of your **5th quarter** at UCSC to declare.

MATH 19A MATH 19B

AM 30 or MATH 23A

AM 10 or MATH 21

AM 20 or MATH 24

CSF 12

CSE 13S or ECE 13

CSE 16

CSE 30

PHYS 5A/L or PHYS 6A/L

PHYS 5C/N or PHYS 6C/N

Earn at least a 2.3 GPA in the major qualification courses. That's a C+ average.

Make sure to take all classes you are using for major requirements for a letter grade.

Declare

Declare your major no later than your 6th quarter at UCSC.
